Need for Investment in Africa

- Large proportion of population (about 68%) has no access to electricity
- Current per capita consumption is very low – 150 kWh/year
- Targets are to add 30,000 MW generation capacity and 60 million new connections in next 15 years
- Investment requirements of USD 500 billion in generation and USD 350 billion in transmission

Power Sector Opportunities in Africa

- New power generation (mainly gas and solar)
- Efficiency enhancement
- Connection through build up of urban, rural and mini-grids
- Renewable opportunities (solar and wind)
